Bakersfield Kart Raceway

Bakersfield Raceway was initially opened in 1959/1960. It was designed for 60's style karts and remains in its original configuration. It is an excellent vintage kart facility. It has been the site of many State and National Events and is a driver's challenge with both uphill and downhill sections. The track lies in the foothills several miles Northeast of Bakersfield. Track owner Rusty Sanders has secured a 40 year lease and has completed the refurbishment of the facility. Improvements include newly planted

grass infield, covered grid, scoring stand, grandstands, restrooms, snack bar and RV, trailer and spectator parking.

Directions to the Track

These are new directions from last year, due to still existing road construction in the track area.

From Hwy 99 coming North or South into Bakersfield-
Take exit 26/26A- 24th. street, Rosedale, -178 East- exit from the freeway. Head due East on 178 East thru the heart of the city. Stay on 178 East toward Lake Isabella. Turn left/north onto Mt. Vernon, crossing over the freeway. Proceed on Mt.Vernon (past Football stadium on left) and go past Panorama Drive. As you pass Panorama you will immediately head down hill. As you head down hill you should see the track ahead of you on the right. Bare to the right and head toward Hart Park. Take the first exit after you pass the track on the right. Turn right, followed by another immediate right and strait to the track on left.

From Hwy 58 West, coming from Tehachipi area:

Take Mt. Vernon and turn right (North) as you exit the Fwy. Proceed along Mt. Vernon and follow the directions above.
